

GENERAL GUIDE TO REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

To graduate from high school in Oregon, students must meet certain requirements set by the State Board of Education. School districts may have additional requirements.

OREGON'S CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

| SUBJECT | YEARS OR CREDITS REQUIRED |
|---|-----------------------------------|
| English Language Arts | 4 |
| Mathematics | 3 (all at Algebra 1 and above) |
| Science (scientific inquiry and 2 with lab experiences) | 3 |
| Social Sciences | 3 |
| Physical Education | 1 |
| Health | 1 |
| Second Language The Arts Career & Technical Education (any one area or in combination) | 3 |
| Electives | 6 |
| TOTAL CREDITS | 24 |

School districts may allow students the opportunity to meet these credit requirements through demonstration of proficiency.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the credit requirements, students must also meet the following **Personalized Learning** requirements:

1. Creation of a personal **Education Plan and Profile**.
2. Demonstration of proficiency in **Essential Skills** (reading, writing, and applying math; six additional essential skills will be phased in over time).
3. Participation in **Career-Related Learning Experiences** that connects classroom learning with real life experiences.
4. Completion of **Extended Application**, applying and extending knowledge and skills in new and complex situations that relate to personal and career interests and post-high school goals.
