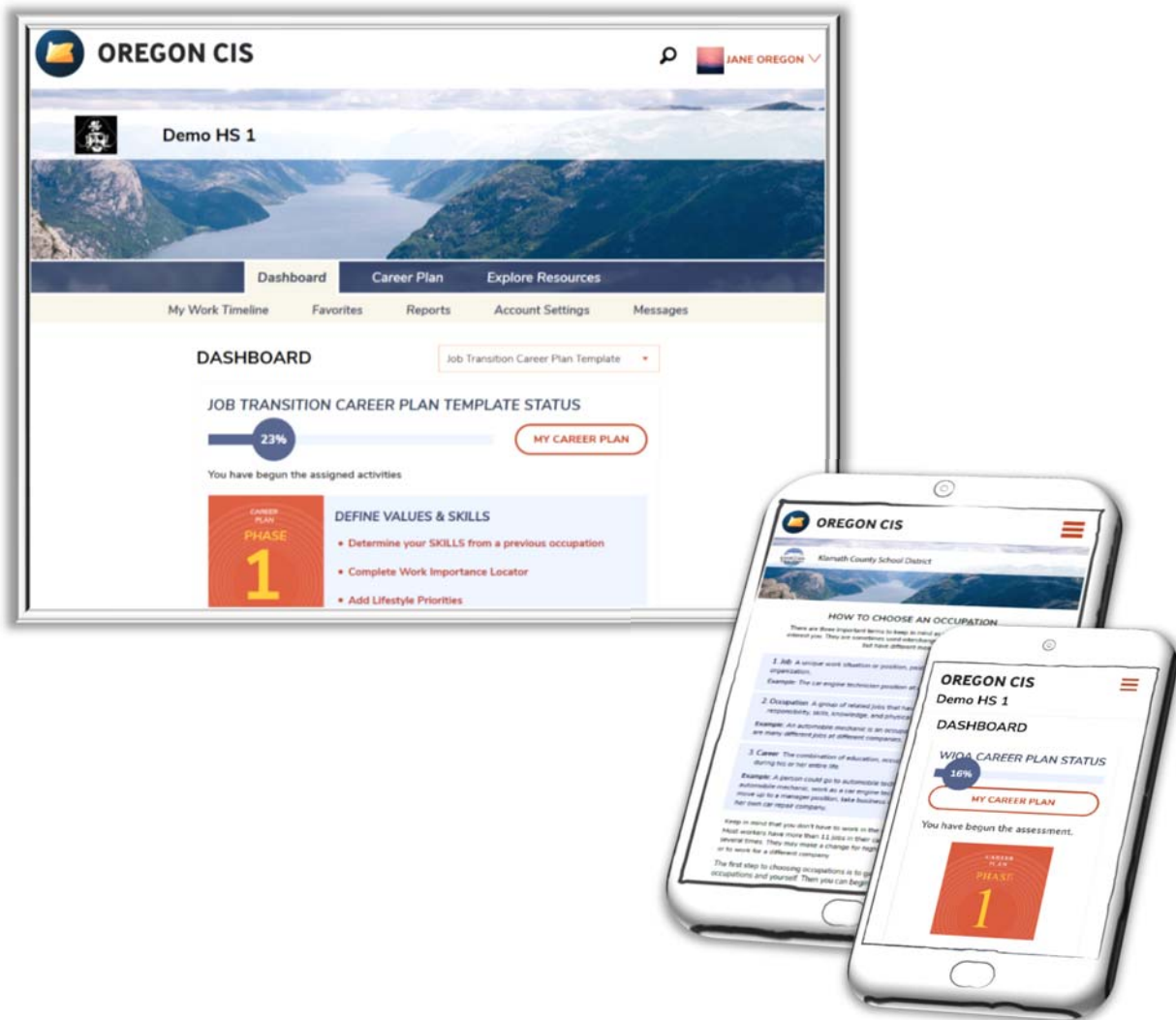

Degree Type: Career Pathway Certificate

Created to give students the basic knowledge needed to succeed in any apprenticeship-level job for preparing personal income taxes. This less-than-one-year certificate gives the student basic bookkeeping knowledge, payroll knowledge, and the required 80-hour basic tax course to sit for the tax preparer exam. Per Oregon's Board of Tax Practitioners website, any person preparing personal income tax returns for a fee or representing that they do so must be licensed by the Oregon State Board of Tax Practitioners.
